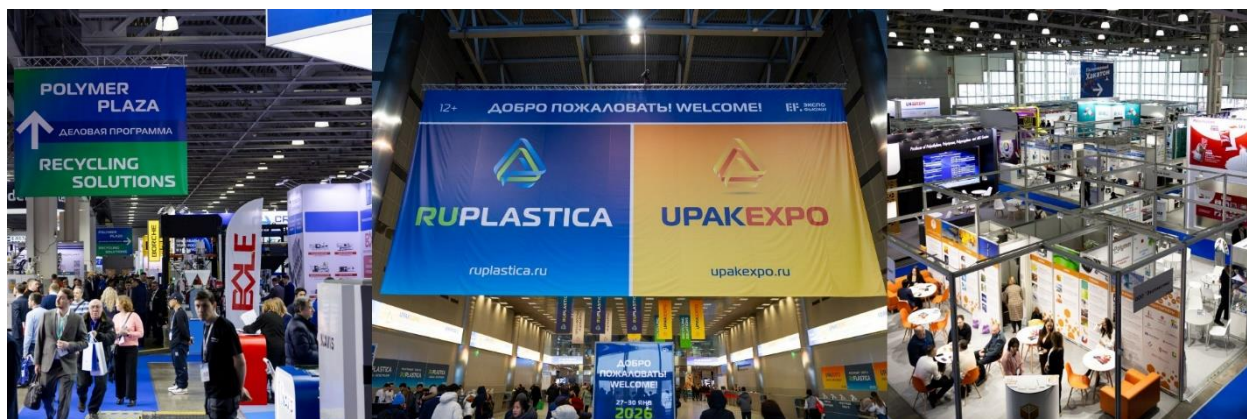


Large-scale opening of the business season at the international specialised exhibitions RUPLASTICA, UPAKEXPO and RECYCLING SOLUTIONS 2026

*From January 27 to 30, the Crocus Expo IEC hosted the largest international exhibitions for plastics and rubber **RUPLASTICA**, packaging solutions for food and non-food industry **UPAKEXPO**, and waste management and recycling **RECYCLING SOLUTIONS**.*



This season, the venue was visited by over **31 000 specialists**, and **over 1 000 companies from several dozen countries** participated in projects. printing – **ADDITIVE MINDED** and **International Polymer Hackathon** in the discipline "Chemistry and Physics of Polymers" for final-year university students.

Over four days of action-packed programming, guests at **RUPLASTICA**, **UPAKEXPO** and **RECYCLING SOLUTIONS** exhibitions were able to learn about key trends and tendencies in various segments of the polymer, packaging, processing, and industrial 3D technologies industries, engage in personal interactions with dozens of authoritative experts and executives from leading market companies, and gain a wealth of business solutions and technologies for their own businesses.
